The companies handle in the region of 500,000 tonnes of scrap metal annually. The majority of the metals that are processed are exported to foundries where they are melted down and manufactured into new metal products. Ferrous Metals are exported directly from Limerick, Galway, and Cork Ports whilst the non ferrous metals are shipped to customers worldwide in containers.

Policy:
